


Plural Noun Rules Posters


Add -s to most nouns to make them plural.

Add -es to nouns that end in ch and sh.

branch branches



brush brushes



Add -es to nouns that end in s and x.

dress dresses




ax axes




In nouns that end with -f or -fe, change the -f or -fe to -ves.


leaf leaves

If the noun ends in -y, with a consonant before the -y, drop the -y and add -ies.
