1. cloud [Noun]
Sentence: Rain fell from a gray cloud in the sky.
Definition: a puffy mass of water droplets in the air
Synonyms: fog, haze

2. mouth [Noun]
Sentence: He looked inside my mouth to check my teeth.
Definition: an opening for eating and talking

3. couch [Noun]
Sentence: The sleeper couch sits three comfortably.
Definition: a large piece of furniture to sit on
Synonyms: davenport, settee, lounge, sofa, sectional

4. pound [Noun]
Sentence: One pound of cheese equals sixteen ounces.
Definition: weight measurement equal to sixteen ounces

5. count [Verb]
Sentence: We should count how many eggs we have left.
Definition: to find the total quantity by adding one by one
Synonyms: tally, add calculate

6. scout [Verb]
Sentence: I will scout out a good place for dinner.
Definition: to search in order to gather information
Synonyms: search, explore

7. found [Verb]
Sentence: They found a lost cat on the street.
Definition: discovered or recovered
Synonyms: discovered

8. shout [Verb]
Sentence: When you shout, I hear you loud and clear.
Definition: to yell or use a loud voice
Synonyms: yell, scream, screech, shriek

9. ground [Noun]
Sentence: She dug a hole in the ground.
Definition: surface of the Earth or floor
Synonyms: earth, floor, dirt, soil

10. south [Noun]
Sentence: On the map, north is up and south is down.
Definition: the direction opposite of north

11. clown [Noun]
Sentence: The circus clown made her laugh.
Definition: strangely dressed comedian or jester
Synonyms: fool, jester

12. crown [Noun]
Sentence: The king wore a crown on his head.
Definition: a special headdress worn by a leader
Synonyms: headdress, tiara

13. drown [Verb]
Sentence: The plants will drown in the rising flood.
Definition: to sink or become covered in a liquid
Synonyms: drench, immerse

14. frown [Noun]
Sentence: I have a frown on my face when I am sad.
Definition: facial expression of disapproval or sadness

15. gown [Noun]
Sentence: My beautiful ball gown swirls when I dance.
Definition: a dress, often for evening wear
Synonyms: dress

16. growl [Verb]
Sentence: The dog will growl if I take away her bone.
Definition: to make a low grumbling angry sound
Synonyms: rumble

17. howl [Noun]
Sentence: A wolf's howl sounds scary at night.
Definition: a long, loud cry
Synonyms: cry, bay

18. owl [Noun]
Sentence: The owl hooted and flew out of the woods.
Definition: a large, nocturnal bird of prey that hoots

19. plow [Verb]
Sentence: A farmer will plow his field with a tractor.
Definition: to dig, break up and turn over earth or soil
Synonyms: till, cultivate

20. town [Noun]
Sentence: A town is smaller than a city.
Definition: a small city
Synonyms: village, city

21. grown [Verb]
Sentence: He has grown two inches taller this year.
Definition: got bigger in size
Synonyms: expanded, increased

22. rough [Adjective]
Sentence: Sandpaper has a rough surface.
Definition: having a bumpy, gritty surface
Synonyms: coarse

23. tough [Adjective]
Sentence: The tough test questions were hard to answer.
Definition: difficult, hard or inflexible
Synonyms: challenging, hard
